



# 2010 JUNIOR LIVESTOCK SALE PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS



**SALE: TUESDAY, AUGUST 31, 2010**  
**LOCATION: Colorado State Fair Events Center**

**INVITATION-ONLY BUYER SOCIAL 2:00 PM**  
**PUBLIC SALE BEGINS..... 3:15 PM**

1. The 2010 Junior Livestock Sale is a terminal sale. All livestock that qualifies for the sale in the Jr. Livestock Competition must sell in the Junior Livestock sale. All livestock offered for sale must have been entered and shown in their respective Junior Market classes at the 2010 Colorado State Fair. The Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Market Beef, Hog, Lamb, Goat, Market pen of 3 Rabbits and Market pen of 3 Poultry along with all remaining sale posted qualifiers must sell in this sale. In addition, all designated livestock that qualifies for sale will be ultra sounded on Monday prior to sale. Junior Market Livestock exhibitors who qualify for the sale will be responsible for the care, control, custody, and feeding of their animals until loaded for slaughter at sale's termination. All Colorado State Fair General rules, Junior Livestock competition requirements, General Livestock competition requirements and Health requirements apply.
2. All market sale animals must have had a justifiable premises identification number through the Colorado State Fair Livestock entry office. Pursuant to 3 CCR 1208-1 8.4 (a). Animals going to custom slaughter will be sent to a slaughtering facility designated by the Colorado State Fair. The Colorado State Fair is responsible for delivery of sale animal to the slaughter processing facility.
3. Sellers will be limited to sell one animal. Unless, if an exhibitor qualifies with more than one of the Grand or Reserve Grand Champion animals, then the seller shall sell all Champion qualifying animals. Exhibitors making sale with more than one species must sell their highest placing animal. The only exception to this rule is, if an exhibitor qualifies with more than one species with the same placing, only the animal selected by the exhibitor for the sale shall be considered terminal. The exhibitor must report to the Livestock office immediately following the market show to declare which animal he or she selects to sell.
4. The Sale Advisory Committee and Colorado State Fair officials will select approximately 40 beef, 40 hogs, 40 lambs; 18 goats, including Grand Champions and Reserve Grand Champions; 2 Rabbit pens, 2 Poultry pen Grand and Reserve Grand Champions only. The sale animals posted includes alternates. All sale animals posted will be in the sale. Those sale posted animals will be housed in a designated secured area of the Colorado State Fair ground until after sale day. NO animal posted will be allowed to leave the Colorado State Fair premises except by movement directly to slaughter after the sale.

5. Sale selection process will be as follows:
  1. Grand Champion
  2. Reserve Grand Champion
  3. Weight or Breed Division Champions in order of showing
  4. Weight or Breed Division Reserve Champions in order of showing
  5. Continue going through the highest placing in order of showing
  6. In the Market Beef show, a similar % of the heifer classes would sell
  7. In the event that all equivalent placing within the species can not make sale, the eligible participant names will be put into a drawing and will be selected at random until the maximum numbers are reached
  8. A sale list will be posted immediately after each Grand Champion drive, listing the maximum allowed sale number for that species (40-Beef, 40-Hogs, 40-Lambs, 18 Goats, 2-Pens of Rabbits and 2-Pens of Chickens.) No alternates will be posted
  9. Those animals posted will be in the sale. No animal posted will be allowed to leave the Colorado State Fair premises.
  10. All selected sale animals will be housed in a designated secured area on the Colorado State Fair grounds.
  
6. All exhibitors whose livestock has been selected for sale must sell their own livestock with the exception of illness (with Physicians statement) or if they are showing more than one (1) Grand / Res. Champion. Any exhibitor to which either of these exceptions apply must make written request for another youth (2010 Colorado State Fair youth exhibitor) to show their sale animal at the Junior Livestock sale. The exhibitor and substitute must appear before the Sale Advisory Committee for final decision. Colorado State Fair will not permit anyone who violates this rule to enter into the sale ring and shall be barred from selling that animal that has been fitted. The exhibitor shall forfeit his right to sell and shall forfeit all premium monies won at the CSF.
  
7. Any failure or refusal to show a qualifying animal in the Junior Livestock Sale shall result in the exhibitor's forfeiting all awards, premiums, and buy-backs earned at the Colorado State Fair. In addition, said exhibitor shall be barred from showing any type of exhibit on the grounds at the Colorado State Fair for a period of three years. Finally, the Colorado State Fair may report any and all competition violations, including failing or refusing to sell, to the North American Livestock Show and Rodeo Managers Association.
  
8. All Junior Livestock sale animals must be groomed with accepted grooming practices only prior to entering the sale ring. NO ARTIFICIAL DECORATIONS, lettering, paint or glitter, etc. of any type will be permitted on any animal entering the sale ring. Show awards won are allowed. Violators of this competition requirement will not be permitted to continue in the Livestock Sale.
  
9. The Colorado State Fair officials, Colorado State Veterinarian and/or Sale Advisory committee have the authority to achieve examinations or additional testing without recourse from the exhibitor. The Colorado State Fair Management and Sale Advisory Committee reserve the right to mark sale animals before and after the sale in any manner they desire.

10. The exhibitor is responsible for the care and feeding of his/hers animal until it has been loaded following the sale. If, in the opinion of the Colorado State Fair General Superintendent, the competition requirements have not been complied with, personnel will be hired to tend to the stock and the cost of that person will be deducted from the sale price due to the seller. Payment to the exhibitor will not be made until all testing has cleared and payment from the purchasers to the Colorado State Fair has been received. The sale premiums for any sale animal on which a lien has been recorded shall be paid directly to the lien holder pursuant to Colorado law.
11. A commission charge of (10%) of the gross sale price will be levied against the Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion animals and (5%) on all other animals sold in the Junior Livestock Sale. The Colorado State Fair will withhold from the gross market sale proceeds of each sale animal fees for testing, trucking, handling charges, taxes and prorated deductions, in addition to the percentage fee. The offer to buy is only a guarantee of acceptance at a given price provided the participant has met all other conditions of the competition terms and Competition Requirements governing the sale.
12. The Colorado State Fair endorses and supports the United States Department of Agriculture Wholesome Meat Act as referenced in the Junior Livestock Competition Requirements. Sellers must comply with Colorado State Fair requirements for shipping and processing.
13. The Colorado State Fair will send the sale exhibitor his/her buyers' addresses shortly after the conclusion of fair. Each exhibitor who sells his/her animal is highly encouraged by the Colorado State Fair to send thank you notes immediately after receiving address.
14. If any animal is condemned at slaughter for any reason, the exhibitor will not receive payment for that animal and shall hold Colorado State Fair harmless for any matter related to combination of said animal. The Colorado State Fair is not liable for any breaches of contracts between the seller and buyer.
15. All sale checks must be cashed or deposited by December 31, 2010. No sale checks will be reissued after December 31, 2010.
16. The Colorado State Fair awards banners and special awards to all Grand and Reserve Grand champion buyers.
